Applications must be postmarked *no later than June 1, 2019.*

A letter of recommendation (from a school principal, guidance counsellor, art teacher or other teacher) is required for entrance scholarship consideration. Referees are asked to complete the evaluation form and return it **directly** to the above address.

CNVAS will inform scholarship winners by mid-September. (Note: Winners will receive their scholarships in the second term upon re-admittance.)

Applicants must be attending school within the boundaries of NLESD Central Region or have been a resident of one of the communities from within that boundary.

Persons of any age may apply. Applicants do not have to be, or have been, members of CNVAS.

Scholarships will be awarded based on the following criteria: academic achievement, financial need, previous art experience, artist's statement, and a subjective evaluation based on awards, achievements, relevant community involvement, and referee's recommendation.

These scholarships will not be awarded to the same person in two consecutive years.

** Mature students with no relevant academic records to submit will be considered on an equal basis with other applicants.*
