Annual Youth Art Competition 2018 Information Package

The aim of the CNVAS Youth Art Competition is to encourage creative ability by awarding prizes in the three age categories. It is open to youth of the Central Region. Three prizes will be awarded in each division:

1. Grade 4-6
2. Grade 7-9
3. Grade 10-12

All entries from Kindergarten Grade 3 will be acknowledged individually.

Awards will be determined by a panel of judges selected by CNVAS and will be presented in Grand Falls-Windsor at the Gordon Pinsent Centre for the Arts. All winning entries will receive advance notice via telephone by **Friday, March 30, 2018** with confirmation of the presentation date at that time (tentatively, April 11, 2018 at the Gordon Pinsent Centre for the Arts, Grand falls-Windsor).

General Regulations:

All entries must be received **no later than 3:00 p.m.** on **Thursday, March 15, 2018.**

Entrants must be residents of the province of Newfoundland and Labrador, from the Central Region, and must be no younger than 5 years of age or older than 18 years of age as of **April 30, 2018.**

Any one entrant may submit no more than one entry.

The entry must not exceed 16" x 20" and be no smaller than 8" x 10".

Entries must be accompanied by a signed statement to the effect that:

- the work is original;
- the work is not part of a class exercise;
- it is the work of the entrant;
- it has been completed within the last twelve months;

- it has not been submitted, and is not concurrently submitted, to another competition;
- the copyright remains the property of the competitor;
- the competitor is prepared to permit the entry to become the property of CNVAS for a one year period if selected;
- award winning entries will be exhibited at the Gordon Pinsent Centre for the Arts.

All prizes will normally be awarded in each category if sufficient entries are received.

The awarding of any and all prizes remains at the discretion of the adjudicator(s) and the executive of CNVAS. All winners will be notified by telephone/email. Please ensure your home phone number and email address is included.

All possible care will be taken with each entry but CNVAS will not be responsible for any loss or damage, by accident, theft, fire, or otherwise. CNVAS assumes no responsibility for the safe transportation or insurance of any entry and is not responsible for entries submitted without full identification and return address.

Painting and Graphic Art: Entries **must not** be framed or matted.

CNVAS will be responsible for the cost of framing and matting the winning entries in each divisional category. The title of the entry, the name, address and telephone number of the artist as well as the school address must be affixed to the back of the artwork.

Works may also be signed on the image in the usual manner.

The subject matter or theme of the artwork is at the discretion of the entrant. Suggested materials are: watercolor, acrylic, oil paint, collage, pastels, pencil, pen and ink, charcoal, etc. on appropriate paper, canvas or canvas board.

IMPORTANT:

All entries from outside Grand Falls-Windsor must include a self addressed, stamped envelope or appropriate packaging with sufficient return postage. This will ensure entries are returned following the competition. Alternately, submissions may be picked up if prior arrangements have been made with the CNVAS coordinators.

Following the awards, all entries submitted by schools in Grand Falls-Windsor and other students from Grand Falls-Windsor who have submitted on an individual basis will be returned to the schools. Should a student change schools it will be the responsibility of the student/parent to obtain the artwork from the originating school. The entry will be returned in the condition it was received (unframed & without a mat).

For award winning entries, a student whose work has been on exhibit at the Gordon Pinsent Centre for the Arts and who wishes to obtain the art work after the one year exhibit period may contact CNVAS to make personal arrangements for pick up. CNVAS assumes no responsibility for entries which do not comply with this request or other guidelines as outlined in the package.
